Department of Community Services

- Community supports for adults: supervised apartment, community residences (closed unless exceptional circumstances exist).
- Homes for special care include: Residential Care Facilities (RCF'S), Group homes, Adult Residential Centres (ARC'S) (not available in this area). Residential Rehabilitation Centre's (not available in this district). Call Dartmouth 424-1600, Halifax 424-6111, Windsor 798-8319. Referral needed.

Metro Community Housing Association

A non-profit organization that rents to persons who may need support. Call Doug Campbell. Referral needed 453-6444

Metro Regional Housing Authority

Works with Connections Clubhouse, SCOT team and New Beginnings. Can self-refer 420-6000

Support Services Group Co-operative

Supportive services and co-op housing. Must have funding available such as social services 466-0230

Clubhouse Connections

Supported housing to clubhouse members 473-8692

New Beginnings Clubhouse

The housing unit, help and support in finding housing for members 464-3588

Phoenix House

For youth ages 16-24. Three types of housing: residential units, supervised apartments and emergency shelter. Can self-refer 446-4663

Venite Court

Housing and support for women 16 or older with a fixed low income. Affiliated with Adsum House but open to all women. Must have financial support such as social assistance set up 425-3466

Emergency Housing

Metro Turning Point

A night shelter for men. Also offers clothing, counselling, recreational programs, detox and long term stable accommodation 420-3282

Salvation Army Addictions and Rehabilitation

For men only, \$4.75 per night 422-2363

Adsum House

Emergency shelter for women and children aged 16 and over 423-4443 (crisis) or 429-4443

Bryony House

Shelter for emotionally and physically battered women and their children 423-7183
