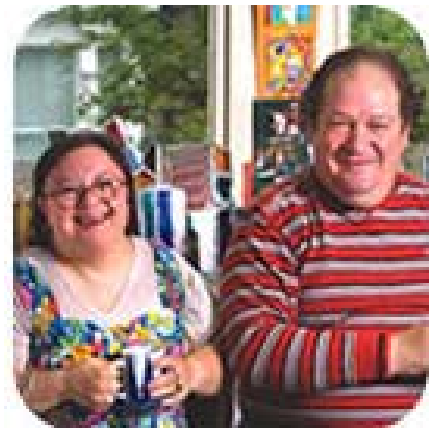

Who are We?

We are a provincial program that serves adults aged 18-65 with developmental disabilities and mental health concerns.

- COAST is an outpatient program that provides services to adults at home or at their place of work.
- Emerald Hall is an 18-bed inpatient active treatment unit.



Staff of Emerald Hall and COAST work together.

Our Team Includes

A Psychiatrist, a Medical Doctor, a Nurse Manager, Nurses, Developmental Workers, a Social Worker, and an Occupational Therapist.

Criteria for Referral to COAST

- 18-65 years old
- Referral from family doctor, with family consent
- Moderate to severe developmental delay and/or autism

Criteria for Admission to Emerald Hall

- Must be recommended by the COAST team.
