After Prostatic Needle Biopsy (P.N.B.)

Following your Prostatic Needle Biopsy, you should also receive a patient teaching pamphlet on Cystoscopy.

Important points

- You will probably have some blood in your urine. This should clear up within 24-48 hours.
- Drink plenty of water or juices to help flush your bladder.
- You may notice some blood in your bowel movements for a couple of days after your surgery.
- Your doctor will have the results of the biopsy in about 7-10 days.

Call your doctor if you have:

- Fever or chills that do not go away.
- Bright blood in your urine that is not clearing up within 24-48 hours.
- Blood in your bowel movement after several days.

If your surgeon or family doctor is not available, go to the Halifax Infirmary Emergency Department.
