(2) For those currently on the Attendance Support Program-consults to Attendance Support Advisors to case manage. (3) Rehab Consultants: provision of return to work as soon as safely possible.  Absences related to Workplace conflict will be consulted onto Labor Relations to ensure resolution of issues so employee returns to work.
