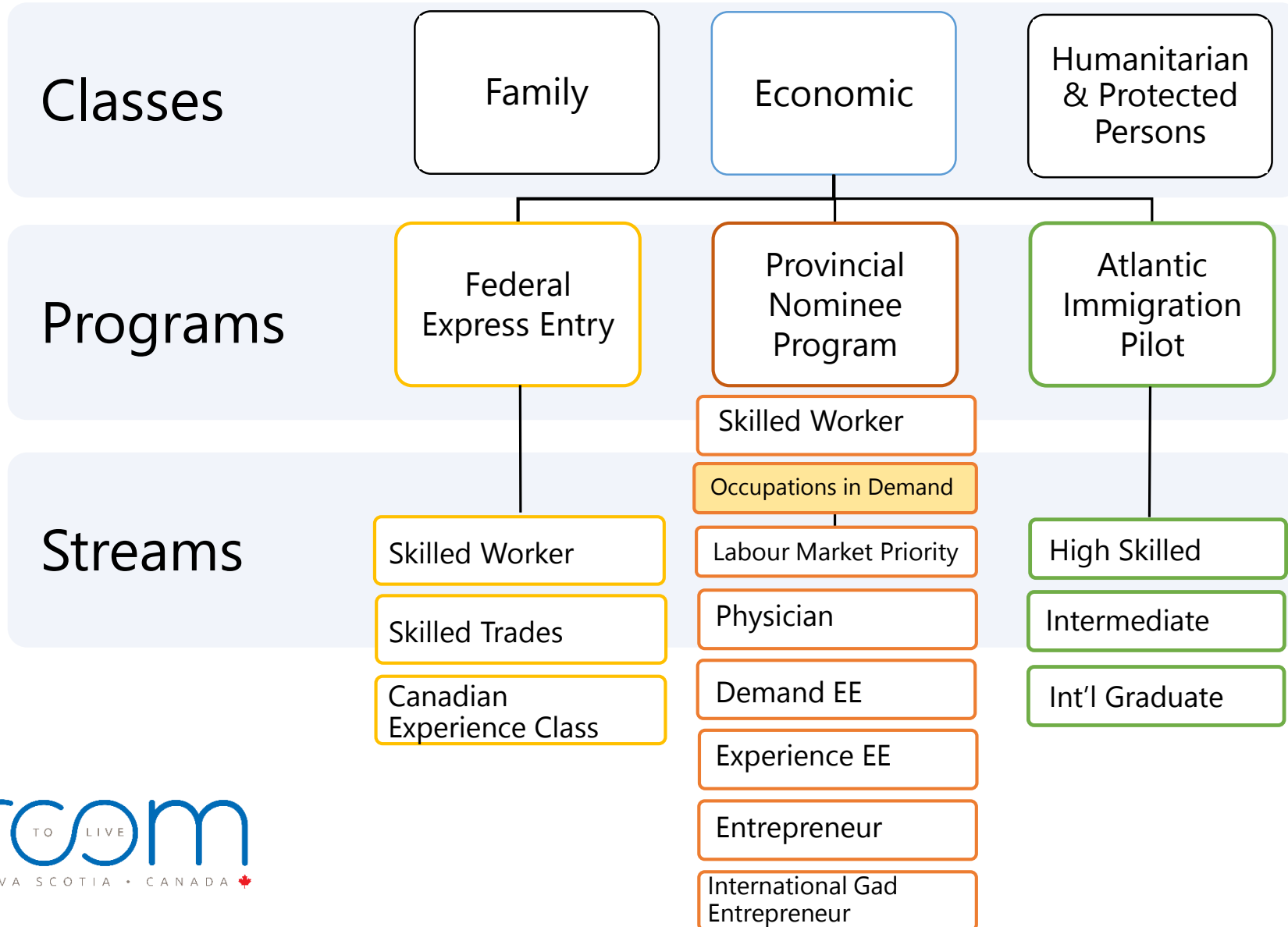

Occupations in Demand Pilot

New Pilot:

- 3 year pilot of stream for NOC C occupations
- Targets high labour market demand
- First occupations will be
 - Continuing Care Assistants
 - Truck Drivers
- Applicants must have full-time permanent job offer
- At least one year of work experience
- Do not require work experience with a NS employer

Rationale:

- This innovative pilot will provide flexible options for employers with labour market gaps in in-demand intermediate skilled occupations.
