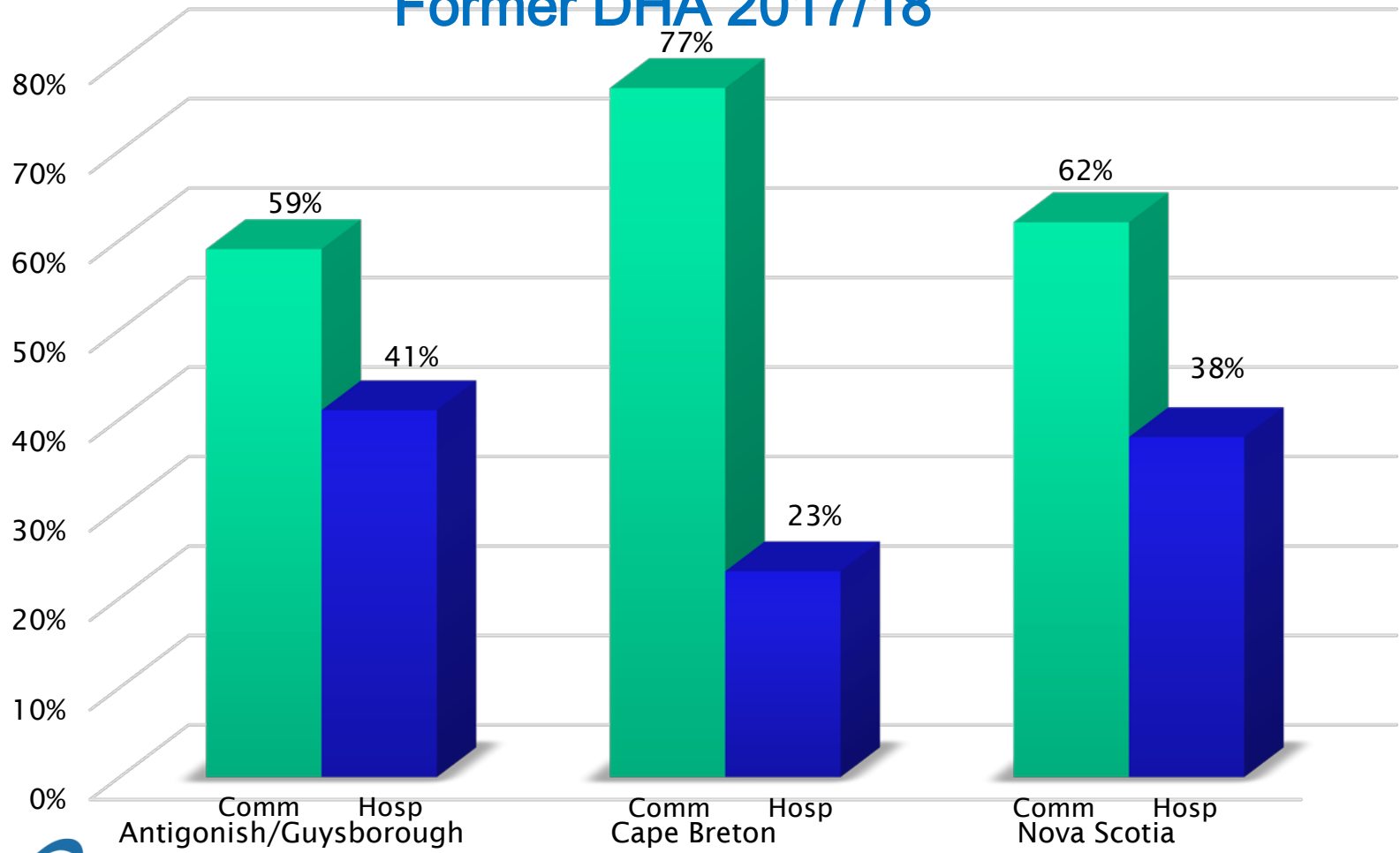
Long Term Care Data – Eastern Zone
