

Dr. Stephanie M. Kaiser, has been re-appointed as the Head of the Division of Endocrinology and Metabolism at the Queen Elizabeth II Health Sciences Centre.

Dr. Kaiser was the Program Director for the Dalhousie Endocrinology Residency Training Program for over 10 years until May 2013. She was Specialty Committee Chair for Endocrinology and Metabolism for the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and still sits on the Nucleus Committee. She is a member of the Osteoporosis Canada Scientific Advisory Council and is on the Executive Committee as well as co-Chair of the Knowledge Translation committee. She was the co-author for the Osteoporosis Clinical Practice Guidelines in 2002 and again in 2010. She is a co-investigator for the Canadian Multicentre Osteoporosis Study. Dr. Kaiser has over 50 publications in peer-reviewed journals. She is currently President-Elect of the Canadian Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (CSEM) and will take over as President in October 2013.

Dr. Kaiser was the recipient of the CSEM 2009 Educator of the Year Award and recently was awarded the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal for her work in osteoporosis.
