

Northside Family Collaborative Practice's Pneumococcal Project (2019-20 Quality Goal)

Goal: Offer 80% of active patients, 65 years and older, the pneumococcal vaccine during regular office visits by January 2020.

Immunization Guidelines:

- All Adults 65 years of age or older, regardless of risk factors or previous pneumococcal vaccination receive 1 dose of Pneu-P-23,
- At least 8 weeks after any previous dose of Pneu-C-13 vaccine and at least 5 years after any previous dose of Pneu-P-23 vaccine¹.

Measurements:

- ✓ Baseline Data required multiple sources:
 - EMR (included last 7 years given in office),
 - Public Health Records (given in hospital, patient unsure), and
 - Paper Charts (include patients who received prior to EMR).
- ✓ All types of Pneumococcal vaccine
- ✓ Patients seen in the last 5 years

Tips & Tricks:

- ✓ Use EMR flag to easily identify patients

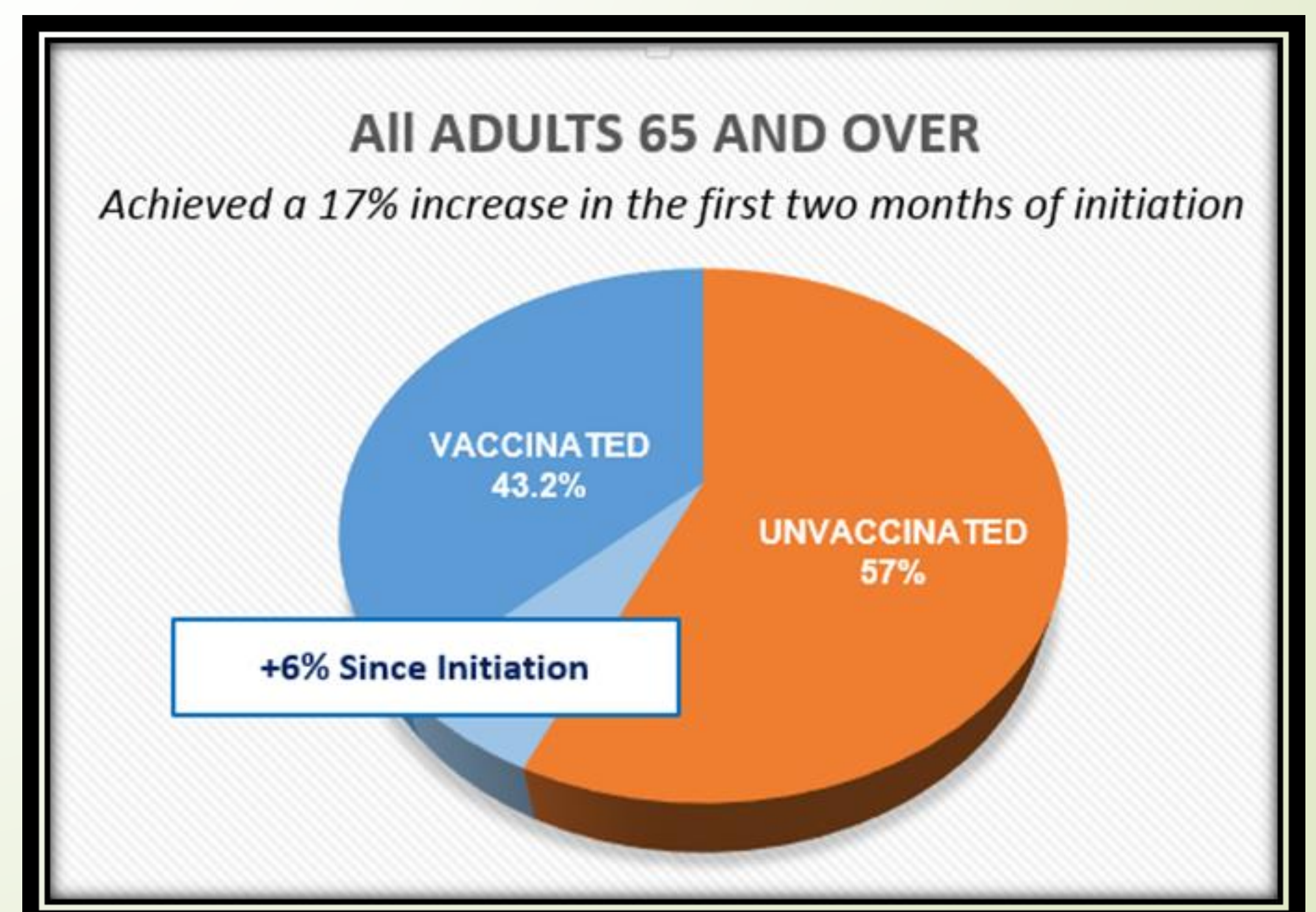


Ask Pneumovax Status
