Subject: **Updated Suspension of some Diagnostic Services for COVID-19 Third Wave**

Pathology and Laboratory Medicine (PLM) in Central Zone has enacted our business continuity planning due to an unprecedented increase in demand for services related to COVID-19 testing. The following revised list of services are suspended for an additional two weeks, and then reassessed.

- Autopsy service
- Male fertility testing
- Hemoglobin A1C* (**new exception below**)
- RBC Folate
- Fecal Occult Blood
- Urinalysis** (exception below)
- Antibody titres
- Cold agglutinins
- Thermal amplitudes
- Decreased frequency in routine HLA antibody testing
- Delay in non-urgent molecular testing reporting
- Reporting of routine Pap smears will be delayed (**new**)

Note: Previous memo Apr 23/21 identifying suspension in some Microbiology testing is unchanged

In addition frontline clinicians are encouraged to reduce the ordering of laboratory testing by limiting to testing required for immediate diagnosis or management of chronic illness. Blood work that does not fit in the criteria above should not be ordered at this time. If patients have been issued requisitions, and the testing is non-urgent, please advise them to delay booking appointments until regular laboratory service is reinstated. Review of inpatients' standing orders is recommended in an effort to reduce the volume of blood collection and testing.

*Exception: Pregnant females and children 19 years and under, and newly diagnosed diabetics. In these situations please indicate on the requisition: "DO NOT CANCEL Hemoglobin A1C."

**Exception: patient requires a urinalysis due to an acute kidney condition, please indicate on the requisition: "DO NOT CANCEL urinalysis as the patient has an acute kidney condition"
